The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Robert Steingrabe, with Donald Bolinger in attendance. Joseph Whiting was absent. Guests present were Joyce Boos, Jennifer Harvey, and Pastor Rob Cypher. The pledge to the flag was given.

#### Township Reports

#### Unfinished Business

There was nothing to report on the sewer project.

Mr. Bolinger made a motion to accept the quote received from Hacketts Tree Service in the amount of \$18,700, seconded by Mr. Steingrabe. Roll call vote: Joseph Whiting – absent, Robert Steingrabe – yes, Donald Bolinger – yes. Quote packages were sent out to multiple tree services.

Mr. Bolinger made a motion to purchase a 2025 F600 truck chassis from McCandless Ford and the upfit through Stephenson's Equipment. The purchase will be paid for through the general fund and reimbursed through the LSA grant. Mr. Steingrabe seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Joseph Whiting – absent, Robert Steingrabe – yes, Donald Bolinger – yes.

Mr. Bolinger made a motion to hire Jennifer Harvey as Secretary-Treasurer at a rate of \$22/hour with Cindy Black staying on through the end of the year as needed, seconded by Mr. Steingrabe. Roll call vote: Joseph Whiting – absent, Robert Steingrabe – yes, Donald Bolinger – yes.

A tiger boom will be rented for trimming brush that cannot be reached with the mower, and a roller will be rented for groove grading.

There is a recall on the F600. More information will be coming soon.

The township is still in need of an Emergency Management Coordinator.

Mr. Bolinger made a motion to purchase and install a Generac generator from Gravatt Generators in the amount of \$15,175, seconded by Mr. Steingrabe. Roll call vote: Joseph Whiting – absent, Robert Steingrabe – yes, Donald Bolinger – yes.

There is no update on an ATV Ordinance.
