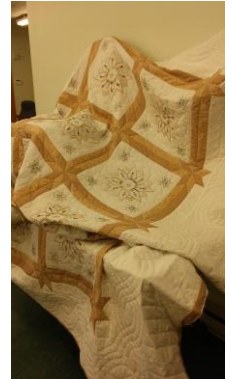

You can now choose who you can get your building permit from: Richardson Inspection Services or T.W. McCosby. Whichever you choose, you will still be required to get your zoning permit from Richardson Inspection Services.

If you choose to go through T.W. McCosby, you can get your application from the township building or the township's website at www.wilmingtontownship.com. You will need to drop off your application, pay, and pick up your permit at the township office. Payment must be in the form of a check.

If you choose to go through Richardson Inspection Services, you can get your application from the township building or the township's website at www.wilmingtontownship.com. You may drop off your application, pay and pick up your permit at the township office. If you pay at the township office, you must pay with a check. You can also use their online application process and pay with a charge card by going to www.richardsoninspectionsservices.com.

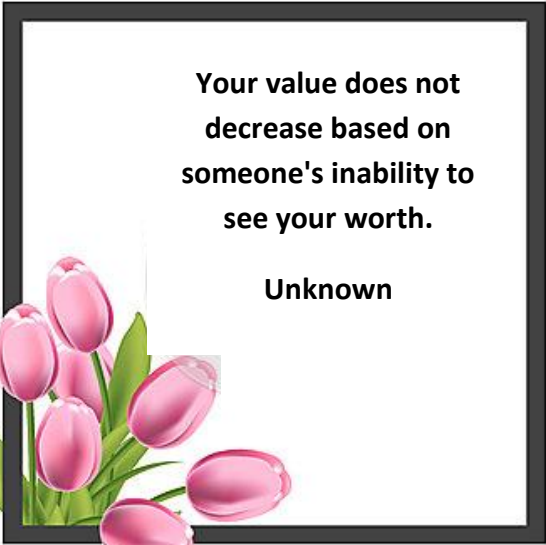
