

The Wilmington Township Mercer County Board of Supervisors met on September 14, 2016, in the township building. The meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by Richard Wilson, with Chad Taylor and Bill Roth in attendance. Guests present are on attached sign in sheet. The pledge to the flag was given.

Public Comment

The August 10, 2016 meeting minutes were approved by a motion from Mr. Taylor, seconded by Mr. Roth. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

Mr. Roth made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, Mr. Taylor seconded. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

Communications

Ms. Black shared a thank you from the Civic League to the Board for helping with the corn roast.

Township Reports

There was nothing to report from the MCRPC, MCRCOG, MPO, and EIT meetings.

Unfinished Business

Ms. Black stated that the 537 Plan is being worked on. The Borough has decided to postpone meeting with the Board about a joint municipal sewer authority until after the issues between the Borough and Wilmington Lawrence is resolved. However, when they do meet, they would like to have a special meeting. Wilmington Lawrence is saying there will be an addition sewer rate increase in 2019.

Rev. Cypher questioned whether the township was still considering gravity lines on Cowden Road. The Board explained the options being looked at.

There was nothing new to report with the Zoning Ordinance update.

Ms. Black stated that the tree service for Number 8 Road quotes came in as follows: Hackett Tree Service - \$9500.00; Richardson Tree Service - \$11578.97; Thomas Tree Service - did not send in a quote. Mr. Taylor made a motion to accept Hackett Tree service's bid for Number 8 Road in the amount of \$9500, seconded by Mr. Roth. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

New Business

The Planning Commission did not meet.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to advertise budget workshop dates for all Thursdays in October and also make the last 3 Mondays in October alternate dates, seconded by Mr. Roth. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to extend the Becdir agreement for another year at the amount of \$1500, seconded by Mr. Roth. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

Ms. Black announced the following quotes were received for 4 culverts on Garrett Road, one on Brenneman Road and one on Anderson Road: Sonntag's - \$16520; Dan Cooper - \$19399; Wilson's - \$19850; Schwartz's - \$20400. Mr. Taylor made a motion to accept Sonntag's bid for the culvert work in the amount of \$16520, seconded by Mr. Roth. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

Mr. Wilson reported that the secretary will be out on vacation the third week in September.

Mr. Taylor made a motion to pay the bills and payroll, Mr. Roth seconded. Roll call vote: Richard Wilson – yes, Chad Taylor – yes, William Roth – yes.

Public Comment

Fred Ware questioned the newest ordinance, informed the supervisors of logs in the ditch on Cowden Road, inquired of trimming an apple tree hanging over the road on Maplewood Drive and informed the Board of reversing the blades on the mower when mowing along road edges.
